### **News from the Board of Administration:**

## Bank Change

The City of Los Angeles is in the process of changing the financial institution it uses to process hard checks and direct deposits. Hard checks and direct deposits for DWP retirees will be processed through the City system beginning August 1, 2009. This change will be automatic and the checks and direct deposit slips will look exactly the same. **You do not have to do anything**. However, we encourage retirees who have outstanding hard checks to deposit them immediately. If you do not deposit these checks by August 31, 2009, you will have to contact the Retirement Office to have them reissued.

# Notice to Retirees' Changes in Income Tax Withholding

In accordance with new IRS rules, WPERP implemented new 2009 federal income tax withholding tables to determine the amount of federal income tax to withhold from your monthly retirement check. The new tax tables incorporate the new Making Work Pay tax credit on earned income. However, your WPERP retirement allowance is not earned income. Therefore, you may be having less withheld from your paycheck than you need or want.

Now that your have completed your 2008 taxes, please take a moment to estimate how much tax you will owe for 2009 from all your sources of income. Then estimate how much WPERP and any other sources of income will take out for taxes using the amount withheld in April, May or June as the basis for the estimate. Remember, everyone must use the new withholding tables, so less will be withheld from your other sources of income as well. Compare the two estimates and decide if you need to increase the amount of withholding from your WPERP retirement check.

For additional help, get IRS Publication 919, "How Do I Adjust My Tax Withholding" or visit the IRS website at <a href="www.irs.gov">www.irs.gov</a> and use the "Withholding Calculator." As with all tax matters, we also recommend that you discuss this issue with your personal tax advisor.

If you decide to increase your withholding from WPERP, contact the Retirement Office to request a new tax withholding card.
